

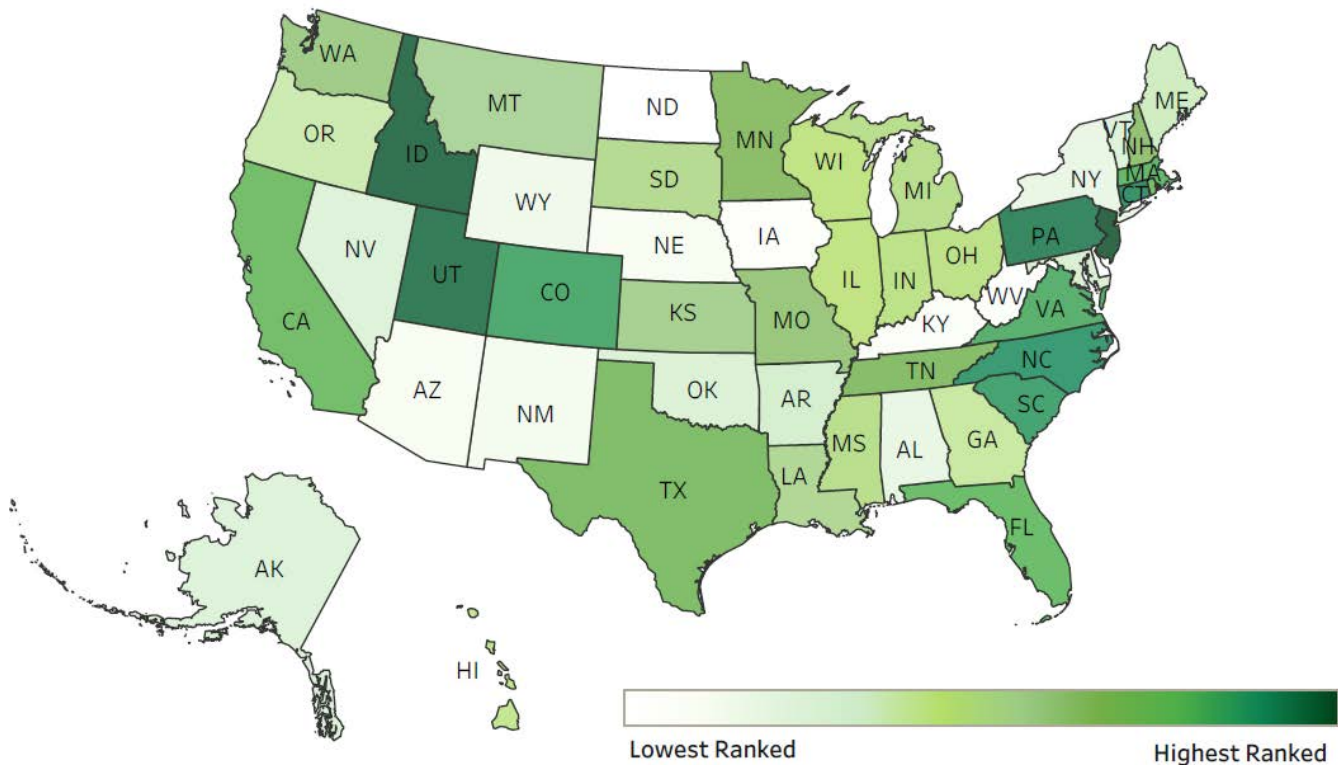
Spring 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade

The Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade assigns an "A," "B," "C," "D," or "F" letter grade to nearly 3,000 general acute-care hospitals in the U.S. It is the only rating focused on a hospital's ability to protect patients from preventable errors, accidents, injuries, and infections.

The heat map shows which states have the highest (darker green) and lowest (lighter green) percentages of "A" hospitals.
